Dear Solid Waste Disposal Contractor,

As of January 1, 2012, all Solid Waste Disposal Contractor will be required to be permitted with the City of Newburyport Health Department for the collection, removal & transportation of garbage, rubbish, offal, recycling, fats, oils, grease and other substances within the City of Newburyport pursuant to the *Commonwealth of Massachusetts General Law Chapter 111, Sections 31* & the *City of Newburyport Health Department Rules and Regulations Section 5, "Miscellaneous Regulations" "Private Solid Waste Disposal and Collection*. Please see the attached City public notice:

PUBLIC NOTICE

At the meeting of the Newburyport Board of Health on September 22, 2011 the Newburyport Board of Health amended Chapter 5, Section 5 of the Newburyport Board of Health Rules and Regulations in accordance with and under the authority granted by Chapter 111, Sections 31 of the Massachusetts General Laws –M.G.L.

In summary, Section 5, "Miscellaneous Regulations" "Private Solid Waste Disposal and Collection" was amended to permit all commercial, private and public haulers for the collection, removal & transportation of garbage, rubbish, offal, recycling, fats, oils, grease and other substances within the City of Newburyport and sets a schedule of fines to be levied for violation in accordance with Chapter 40, Section 21D of the Massachusetts General Laws.
