Instructions for Completion of the Return:

1. Enter the name(if any) you have given the vessel
2. Type - Enter P (for power), S (for Sail) or O (for Other)
3. Make of Vessel - Manufacturer's Name (if homemade, so indicate)
4. Hull Identification Number
5. State Registration Number or Federal Documented Number
6. Year - Year in which manufactured or homemade
7. Length – exclude bowsprits and similar extensions
8. Color – solid or multitoned, specify colors

Newburyport Marine Waterways Permit fees are based on the length of the registered vessel (as shown on the State Registration or Federal Documentation):

1. For all vessels less than 17 feet in length, there is a flat fee of \$20
2. For all vessels 17 feet or greater, the fee shall be \$3 per foot
3. Each vessel occupying a mooring in Newburyport waters is assessed an additional \$3 per foot (does not apply to vessel on slips, trailers or otherwise stored on land)
4. All vessels greater than 19 feet in length are assessed an additional flat fee of \$10 as a Clean Waters Surcharge

ALL VESSELS, INCLUDING TENDERS AND INFLATABLES, MUST HAVE A STICKER.

Examples:

1. A 30 foot boat on a trailer or slip will pay \$100 (\$3 per foot plus \$10 Clean Water Surcharge)
2. A 30 foot boat moored in a private or city-owned marina will pay \$190 (\$6 per foot plus \$10 Clean Water Surcharge)
3. A 10 foot vessel of any type will pay a flat fee of \$20

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING YOUR NEWBURYPORT MARINE WATERWAYS PERMIT:

1. You must provide a proof of boat excise tax payment for last summer (paid in 2010) if one was due.
All boat excise taxes due must be paid before your Marine Waterways Permit sticker can be issued.
2. Waterways Permit fee is due, payable (No Cash) to “City of Newburyport” by June 1,2010

3. If paying by mail:

Enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope, proof of excise payment, your check and ***this entire form***;

3. If paying in person:

Bring ***this entire form***, proof of excise tax payment and payment for Marine Waterways Permit to the Harbormaster Office (located on the waterfront, to the rear of the Custom House Museum at 25R Water Street)

Applications are due by June 1st; late applications may result in mooring/slip reassignment.
