Certified Professional Food Managers Course (EXPERIOR) is required by all food managers and handlers in restaurants, supermarkets and institutional facilities that require demonstrated competency in food safety and satisfies the Massachusetts State Sanitary Code 105CMR 590.000. Certificates are valid for 5 years.
